This helps students stay fully present and engaged during lessons.

We also encourage conversations about respecting teachers' directions and fostering a positive school environment by using school-appropriate language in the hallways, classrooms, and lunchrooms. These reminders go a long way in promoting a respectful and supportive atmosphere for everyone. We encourage a reminder to respect and accept the differences that make us unique. Together, we'll emphasize the importance of being attentive during instruction, keeping personal devices out of sight, and maintaining a respectful tone when interacting with peers and staff.

While not every student has struggled with these expectations, we've noticed increased behaviors such as inappropriate language and disrespectful responses to staff. As a proactive measure, we're addressing these trends to ensure a positive learning experience for all.

PowerSchool Cyber Security Incident

Recently, communication went out via Messenger informing families of a cybersecurity incident on December 28th. Please see a copy of the communication below.

January 9, 2025

Dear Ben Bronz Families and Staff:

This message informs you of a cybersecurity incident on December 28, 2024, involving unauthorized access to certain information within PowerSchool, our Student Information System (SIS) provider.

PowerSchool notified us on Tuesday, January 7th, of a potential cybersecurity incident involving unauthorized access to certain information which occurred on December 28th within PowerSchool's

customer support portal. An unauthorized party accessed specific SIS customer data, including Ben Bronz Academy's data, through a compromised credential in PowerSchool's customer support portal. PowerSchool does not anticipate sharing or publicizing the data, and it believes it has been deleted without further replication or dissemination.

The information accessed includes data related to students, families, and educators.

PowerSchool immediately engaged its cybersecurity response team and law enforcement. The compromised credential was deactivated, and access to the affected portal has been restricted. An incident report from a 3rd party contracted by PowerSchool is expected by January 17th.

PowerSchool and Ben Bronz Academy are committed to providing support and transparency throughout this process. As more information becomes available, we will keep you informed.

We understand this news may cause concern and sincerely apologize for the incident. We are committed to protecting the privacy and security of your information and working closely with you to address any concerns you may have.





























BOX TOPS FOR EDUCATION
